MEMORANDUM

TO: ALL PROMOTERS

REFERENCE: 2013 Renewal Applications

Enclosed is your renewal application for the 2013 calendar year. Please fill it out completely, sign it, and mail it to the Commission office, along with the \$500.00 license fee, before you arrange your first show in 2013.

Please keep the following in mind:

- When requesting a permit to hold an event, the request needs to list the *site* of the event, all known title fights, and the network if the show is to be televised. See NAC 467.167(2). Date requests need to be submitted, in writing, to the Commission office well in advance and before any tickets can be sold for the event.
- The medical requirements will remain the same for next year.
- There remain special requirements for amateur-to-professional unarmed combatants, and those who need a comprehensive examination and Commission approval. Please submit all such required medical data to the Commission as soon as possible, and definitely no later than two (2) business days before the public meeting on a comprehensive applicant.
- The Commission works with other states to minimize combatants taking duplicate tests. Please have your matchmaker contact the Commission office before your first show.

- The purse check must be made payable to the combatant only; unless: (i) the combatant's manager is a licensee of the Commission and the combatant provides authorization (on the approved Bout Agreement) that the manager can have his/her share paid directly from the purse proceeds; or (ii) the combatant submits an *Assignment of Monetary Interest* on the form provided by the Commission (a copy of that form is attached hereto). The *Assignment of Monetary Interest* form must be given to Commission staff at the weigh-in with the combatant's Bout Agreement. After the bout, it will be the promoter's responsibility to forthwith deliver any and all checks going to non-combatants via the *Assignment of Monetary Interest* form. It is mandatory that all checks for the combatants, managers and assignees, along with copies thereof, be given to Commission staff no later than 45 minutes before the start of the first fight.

- As in previous years, you must provide a current line-by-line record from Fight Fax, Inc. for boxers, or mixedmartialarts.com for mixed martial artists, who you anticipate using on your card and you must keep the Commission up to date on changes to your card.

- NAC 467.272(1) provides that ALL drinks at a program of unarmed combat must be dispensed in paper or plastic cups. Unfortunately we have noticed some venues selling beer in glass bottles. Please make sure to inform the venue in which you are holding your event about this important regulation.

- The Commission utilizes Quest Diagnostics for steroid and drug testing of contestants. Quest will now provide professional sample collectors at the beginning of the event (or, on occasion, at the weigh-in) to collect contestants' urine samples to help ensure compliance with the Commission's steroid and drug testing policies. This approach has worked quite well, and I commend you all for your assistance in this important endeavor.

- We continue to revise and improve the Commission website, <http://boxing.nv.gov/>, so expect to see a much different look to the site very soon. The site is a great reference guide for all licensees, and we hope you take advantage of it. Please let us know if you wish to see additional information on the website.
