

EXPERIENCED BOXING REFEREES AND JUDGES PROCESS

The Nevada State Athletic Commission (NSAC) is recruiting **experienced boxing referees and judges**.

Our goal is to be as transparent and fair to anyone who has interest and wants a chance at a Nevada license.

NSAC requirements for experienced referees and judges:

- **Desire to reside in Nevada**
- Resume and documentation of experience
- Recommendation from current licenser

Timeframe and Process for NSAC Recruitment

October 31st: resume, documentation of experience, and recommendation from current licenser must be submitted

November: Review by Executive Director and Committee of Existing Officials

- Rank order applicant(s)
- Recommendation to Commissioners of who to invite to Nevada for a working interview in an actual fight (4-6 round fight)
- Interaction with other officials

December: Interview by Full Commission for Licensure

- Commission will interview applicant(s)

NEW PROFESSIONAL BOXING REFEREES AND JUDGES FROM THE AMATEURS PROCESS

NSAC requirements of New Professional Officials from the Amateurs

- November 1
 - Must desire to reside in Nevada
 - Submit resume and documentation of experience

- Early December
 - Training Day with a Group Leader and Other Licensed Officials

- Mid December
 - Review the Performance for Training Day
 - Top Candidates Interviewed by Executive Director and Selected Licensees
 - Make recommendation for Commission to invite individual into a shadow/training/probation period

- January
 - Commission Interviews Applicants
 - Selected applicants begin Training Program

Upon Completion of the Training Program Interview by Full Commission for Licensure

Final licensing interview with Commission
