MMA GLOVE APPROVAL POLICY

The Nevada State Athletic Commission (NSAC) requires that any glove manufacturer seeking approval to use a specific **make/model of gloves**, must submit the following listed in sections 1 – 8 at least 21 days recommended prior to a professional contest held in the State of Nevada.

1. Letter from a promoter and/or fighter requesting the use of the specific **make/model of gloves** for an upcoming event scheduled in the State of Nevada.
2. Glove Documentation:
 - a. Product life cycle
 - b. Warnings
 - c. Warranties
 - d. All testing information that the manufacturer has done.
 - e. All information about the manufacturer and the gloves that you would like for us to consider.
3. Tech Pack (Glove Specifications) including but not limited to pictures, dimensions and weights of all materials used in the glove.
4. Sample swatch of all materials used in the glove.
5. 1 pair of each; minimum 4 oz. to maximum 8 oz. gloves, with applicable labels (size of glove, warning labels, product life cycle label). Please note if the gloves submitted does not weigh within two-tenths of an ounce above maximum or below minimum of the applicable weight, the approval process will cease, and new gloves must be submitted.
6. Copy of current business license and proof of liability insurance for the glove company submitting the request. If using an external manufacturer, they also need to submit a copy of current business license and proof of liability insurance.
7. Please provide names and information (email, phone and mailing address) for company representatives.
8. By submitting your gloves for approval:
 - a. You agree that the gloves will be dissected during the review and approval process and will not be returned.
 - b. Furthermore, that all samples provided will be available for display and/or discarded after review, per NSAC policy.
 - c. Should the Commission require any modifications for approval, new gloves as outlined in #5 must be submitted.

Upon receipt of all items, NSAC will review and evaluate gloves and materials for quality and safety standards.

If the specific make and model of glove is approved, it will be added to the NSAC approved glove list located on agency website at https://boxing.nv.gov/faq/sections/Glove_Questions/.
